

TK and Kindergarten Enrollment Requirements

Frequently Asked Questions

Immunization record - does this need to be submitted during TK/Kindergarten enrollment or by my student's first day of school?

Please bring your student's current immunization records with you to on-site enrollment at your resident school site during enrollment. This will allow the office staff to confirm with you if we will require additional immunizations for your student **before** the start of school in August. We require documentation that your student's immunizations are current/age appropriate before your student's first day of school.

• When is the Oral Health Assessment Form due?

The Oral Health Assessment Form is due by May of your students first year of public school (TK, kindergarten or first grade). This form is not required to complete the enrollment process. A California licensed dental professional must perform the check-up. A dental check-up within the 12 months prior to the first day of school meets this requirement.

• Report of Health Examination for School Entry – when is this form required?

The Report of Health Examination for School Entry is recommended, but not required to enroll in TK or kindergarten. It is required **prior** to entering first grade. If you submit this student for TK enrollment another Report of Health Examination for School Entry is due by the start of first grade. At the time of transitional kindergarten or kindergarten enrollment, parents must provide the school with the scheduled appointment date for the physical exam. *For incoming kindergartners, examination between March 1st and the start of school meets the 1st grade examination requirement.*

Developmental Readiness Survey - does this need to be submitted during enrollment?

The Developmental Readiness Survey is not due at the time of enrollment. Please take this form to your student's preschool and ask them to return the completed form to your resident school site.

• When do I submit the Classroom Questionnaire?

Please complete this form and bring it to on-site enrollment. This document is recommended, but not required to complete the enrollment process.
