

Use of Kitchen

- The use of kitchen facilities shall include the assignment of a food service employee to be on duty and in charge of said kitchen, including its equipment and serving facilities.
- The food service employee will provide overall kitchen support and is there to assist you in locating items and to assist with the use and care of the equipment and appliances in the kitchen.
- The user group will be charged a per hour rate as indicated on the [fee schedule](#).
- The Contra Costa County requires a Temporary Food Facilities Permit when food or beverage items are served (either sold or given away) to the public at a “community event.” Permit information can be obtained online at <http://cchealth.org/eh/retail-food/temporary-food.php> or by calling Contra Costa County Environmental Health at 925-692-2500.
