Revisions Due to the Adoption of the State Budget

Revenues

Local Control Funding Formula/Other State –

LCFF increased \$21,749,842 based on the State adopted budget.

Other State revenues increased \$1,957,478 due to reductions in Lottery and the addition of a State grant for COVID-19 LEA Response.

Federal revenues increase \$9,825,167 based on projections for Learning Loss Mitigation grants.

Expenditures

Services and Other Operating Expenses increased \$1,150,000 reflecting COVID-19 grant expenditures.

Routine Budget Revisions

Expenditures

Salaries and Benefits –

Salaries and benefits are decreased \$197,774 because of the elimination of certain certificated FTE related to the Personal Learning Initiative.

Supplies/Services –

Supplies and services are increased an additional \$1,219,972 primarily because of personal protective equipment and distance learning expenses.

RESOLUTION 7/20-21, COMMITTING TO MEET FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS AND MAINTAINING FISCAL SOLVENCY

WHEREAS, the Governing Board has a fiduciary duty to meet its financial obligations in the current fiscal year and two subsequent fiscal years pursuant to Education Code 42127; and

WHEREAS, significant fiscal challenges exist for the forecast periods 2021-22 and 2022-23; and

WHEREAS, multiyear planning factors are limited at this time and may not provide adequate information on which to build a dependable multiple year financial projection for detailed revenues, expenditures and fund balance computations for 2021-22 and 2022-23; and

WHEREAS, current planning factors result in deficit spending that will require corrective actions to maintain the fiscal stability of the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Education of the San Ramon Valley Unified School District, Contra Costa County, California as follows:

1. A safe and high quality education program will be maintained for all students.
2. The district will make timely updates to its multiyear financial projections based on generally accepted planning factors for California K-12 public education.
3. If the fiscal condition of the district further deteriorates, the district will implement all necessary budget adjustments (revenue increases, expenditure reductions, reserve allocations) for 2021-22 and 2022-23 to meet financial obligations and maintain fiscal solvency.
4. The district is committed to fulfilling its obligations to respond to, provide requested information, and take the necessary actions to resolve questions from the County Office of Education regarding the district's financial operations.







WHEREAS good attendance is essential to student achievement and graduation, and we are committed to dedicating our resources and attention to reducing chronic absenteeism rates, with a focus starting as early as transitional kindergarten and kindergarten;

WHEREAS chronic absence – missing 10 percent or more of school for any reason including excused and unexcused absences, or just two or three days a month – is a proven predictor of academic trouble and dropout rates;

WHEREAS improving attendance and reducing chronic absence takes commitment, collaboration and tailored approaches to particular challenges and strengths in each community;

WHEREAS chronic absence predicts lower third-grade reading proficiency, course failure and eventual dropout, it weakens our communities and our local economy;

WHEREAS the impact of chronic absence hits low-income students particularly hard if they don't have the resources to make up for lost time in the classroom and are more likely to face systemic barriers to getting to school – such as unreliable transportation, lack of access to health care, unstable or unaffordable housing;

WHEREAS attendance gaps among groups of students often turn into achievement gaps that undermine student success; Chronic absence particularly exacerbates the achievement gap that separates low-income students from their peers, since students from low-income families are both more likely to be chronically absent and more likely to be affected academically by missing school;

WHEREAS absenteeism also undermines efforts to improve struggling schools, since it's hard to measure improvement in classroom instruction if students are not in class to benefit from them;

WHEREAS schools and community partners can reach out more frequently to absent students to determine what barriers they face to attending school and what would help them attend more regularly;

WHEREAS health care providers can share the importance of school attendance with families and can offer proactive, preventive care to reduce absences;

WHEREAS schools and districts must do more to track, calculate and share the data on how many students are chronically absent so that we can see the attendance gaps and can deliver the right interventions to the right students;

WHEREAS all students, even those who show up regularly, are affected by chronic absence because teachers must spend time reviewing for students who missed lessons;

WHEREAS chronic absence can be significantly reduced when schools, families and communities work together to monitor and promote good attendance and address hurdles that keep children from getting to school; and

WHEREAS schools and community partners help build strong, trusting relations between children, families, teachers, and other critical school staff to have a significant impact on the ability of students to focus and learn in a remote learning environment to be present, engaged and supported;

By bringing attention to name-calling, hate speech, and verbal bullying of all kinds and providing schools, students, and parents with the tools and inspiration to launch an ongoing dialogue about ways to eliminate these acts in our schools and in our community, the schools of the SRVUSD will be a safe place to learn for all students.

WHEREAS No Name-Calling Week, renamed “Words Matter Week” in the San Ramon Valley, is an annual week of educational activities aimed at ending verbal hate and bullying of all kinds and providing schools with the tools and inspiration to launch an ongoing dialogue to eliminate name-calling and bullying in their communities;

WHEREAS 60 organizations, including the National School Boards Association, National Association of Elementary School Principals, National Association of Secondary School Principals, National Education Association, National Association of School Psychologists, Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network, and Big Brothers Big Sisters of America, have come together as No Name-Calling Week partner organizations;

WHEREAS our district-wide participation began in 2014 with the name change to “Words Matter Week” adopted in 2015;

WHEREAS the Gay, Lesbian and Straight Education Network has conducted and released national studies analyzing the pervasive harassment and victimization faced by elementary students and lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer or questioning (LGBTQ) secondary students;

WHEREAS victims of intimidation, harassment, and bullying behaviors perform poorly in school and have a higher rate of school absenteeism;

WHEREAS over 70 percent of LGBTQ middle and high school students frequently hear homophobic remarks and over 74% percent of LGBTQ middle and high school students have been verbally harassed in the past year because of their sexual orientation;

WHEREAS more than one-third of adolescents, nationally, reported being bullied based on their race or ethnic background;

WHEREAS threatening words and taunting behavior regarding one's appearance, ethnicity, race, language, gender, size, and/or special learning needs negatively impacts a student's ability to perform scholastically and leaves a child feeling unsafe in an environment where all children should feel a heightened level of safety;

WHEREAS students with disabilities are two to three times more likely to be bullied than their non-disabled peers;

WHEREAS 1 out of every 4 students, nationally, reported being bullied or called names at some point while in school;

WHEREAS between November 9 and December 12, 2016, over 1000 reports of bias-related harassment and intimidation were reported to the Southern Poverty Law Center, with 226 of them occurring in the K-12 environment;

WHEREAS during the current school year, two of our district high schools have contended with incidents of race-related graffiti; and

WHEREAS the district is involved in a number of efforts to address these concerns and to ensure that all students feel safe at school, including continued expansion of implementation of Culturally and Linguistically Responsive (CLR) Teaching and Learning strategies in all 36 schools, shifting the focus of our District Culture and Climate Committee to partner with families to create spaces which honor diversity, equity, and inclusion continued work by the Equity Task Force with 30 members representing parents, teachers, administrators, students and community members, and the hiring of a district Equity Coordinator responsible for providing staff at all levels of the organization with training to respond to all incidents of racism and discrimination in our community.

WHEREAS drug overdose deaths are the leading cause of injury death in the United States¹ and are highest among people aged 25 to 54 years²;

WHEREAS most teenagers who abuse prescription opioid drugs get them for free from a friend or relative – but those at highest risk of overdose are as likely to get them from a doctor’s prescription³;

WHEREAS in 2018 in Contra Costa County, there were 641,374 prescriptions given to patients for opioids which is an age-adjusted rate of 481.5 prescriptions per 1,000 residents which is higher than the state rate of 456.9⁴;

WHEREAS with more than 67,300 drug overdose deaths estimated nationally in 2018, drug overdose deaths experienced a 4% decrease from 70,237 in 2017 to 67,367 deaths in 2018⁵;

WHEREAS in 2018, nearly 47,000 Americans died from opioid overdoses, an average of 129 people every day¹ and in 2018, 82 Contra Costa County residents died from an opioid overdose⁴;

WHEREAS as many as 1 in 4 people who receive prescription opioids long term for non-cancer pain in primary care settings struggles with opioid addiction²;

WHEREAS each day, more than 1,000 people are treated in emergency departments for not using prescription opioids as directed²;

WHEREAS in 2018 it is estimated that America’s opioid epidemic exacted at least \$78.5 billion in economic costs related to health care, crime and lost work productivity⁶; and

WHEREAS Americans that have participated in DEA’s seventeen National Prescription Drug Take-Back Days have turned in more than 4,508 tons of medication over the past nine years at take-back sites available in all 50 states and U.S. territories⁷, and in Contra Costa County, during the April 2019 DEA sponsored Take-Back Day, 1,628.2lbs of unwanted or unused prescription medication were removed;
