PROPOSAL FOR THE BOARD'S CONSIDERATION

January 4, 2021: All students (including Special Day Classes) will be remote until Contra Costa County moves to the red tier

- Move to new classes and teachers: January 5th
- Pause specialized small groups until at least January 19th

RATIONALE

 We are committed and need to move forward as soon as the data improves (red tier)

 We are responding to this latest surge in terms of the Covid-19 pandemic

KEY QUESTIONS

- If we are staying remote, why do we have to change our classes?
- Why do we need to wait until the red tier?
- Why will our Special Day / English Language / Intervention classes be returning to remote?
- Why are we pausing specialized small groups?

KEY QUESTIONS

- What is the process if I need to change my declaration?
- When will we move from hybrid to fullime?
- Why is my declaration for the rest of the year?

ADDITIONAL CONSIDERATIONS

- Our students' welbeing
- Our students' academic achievement
- Our staff's wellbeing
- Utilizing a metric (tiered system) that is not determined by SRVUSD
